Staff

Camps are staffed by coordinators, counselors and specialists. Each group is led by an adult staff member. The counselors are college and high school students, supervised by the group leaders. Professionals in their respective fields instruct the specialized activities. Group leaders are trained and certified in First Aid and CPR/AED for Professional Rescuers.

Licensing: The Goddard Riverside Community Center Summer Day Camps are licensed by the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and are inspected twice yearly. A Day in the Life of a Camper

8:00 – Early drop off and breakfast
