## *A Small Start with a Big Heart*

More than 40 years ago on the Upper West Side, Bill Moore, a jazz musician, opened his apartment to feed the homeless during the holidays using only a hotplate and good intentions. Over the years, the meal became a community tradition for those alone during the holidays and vulnerable to hunger. But the need quickly outpaced capacity.

In 1985, Goddard Riverside began hosting the gatherings, which today continues Moore's mission and counts more than 2,500 meals served over the two holidays. To do so requires hundreds of dedicated volunteers and their generous support.
