#### **Enriching the Lives of Older Adults**

Goddard Riverside is committed to helping older adults experience an optimal quality of life. This includes Senior Centers, NORCs (Naturally Occurring Retirement Community), Phelps House and Meals on Wheels.

#### **Promoting Behavioral Health and Wellness**

The goal of these programs is for each person to maximize their individual abilities and reach their fullest potential. This includes the ACT Team, TOP Clubhouse, TOP Opportunities and Green Keepers.

#### Fighting Homelessness and Supporting Housing for All

We believe all New Yorkers must have stable and affordable housing. We conduct homelessness prevention work and manage Supportive Housing. This includes Homeless Outreach, The Baxter Safe Haven, Capitol Hall, The Senate Residence, West 140th Street, Corner House, and the Law Project.


#### **Strengthening Families & Communities**

The Good Neighbor Awards are being presented to the following in recognition of their extraordinary work as volunteers in helping build a better community.

Geraldine "Gerri" Collins for her many years of incredible volunteer work, advocacy work, public speaking, her radio show and lobbying to address tenants' rights, housing & homeless issues. Geraldine or "Gerri" is committed to social justice and organizing, showing her leadership and passion by being president of the Phelps House Tenant Association, the National Alliance of HUB tenants and as a committee member to many others. She is a vital link between tenants, Goddard and the wider political and policy landscape, speaking out on injustice through various means. As a driven individual Gerri has lead, collaborated and organized many one-off and annual events for tenants.

Jameka Collins for her volunteer work as a parent leader on the Citywide Council for District 75 (CCD75), and volunteer contributions at the Susan G. Komen Annual Breast Cancer Awareness event and the Uptown Grand Central for their annual Party on the Park Street Resource Fair. As a leader she has shown her care, dedication and compassion helping others on an individual level while juggling home life. Finding time, she has supported other initiatives and events always being a kind and warm person.
